

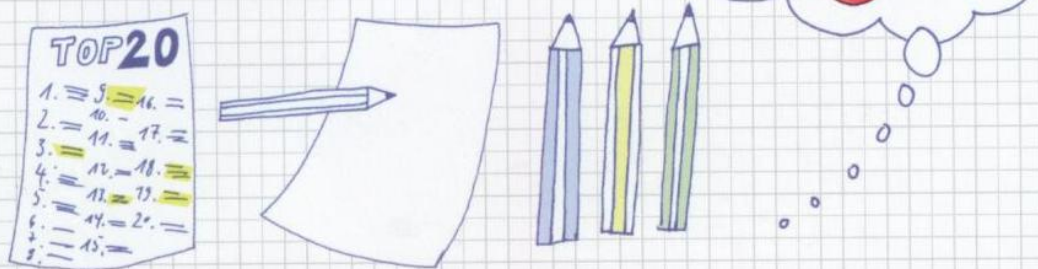
## Games and songs

- > 20 song titles and optionally a few song lines (see Exercise 14, page 12, in your Workbook)
- > pencil and paper
- > a blue, a yellow and a green pen
- > your own imagination



1. The 20 song titles and song lines will help you to write the interview. Include them in your questions and/or answers. Do not change or shorten the song titles or song lines. But you can add more words if necessary (see example below).
2. Highlight the **song titles** and **song lines** in blue.
3. Include one question about the interviewee's favourite song or album.
4. Include at least **3 question tags** and highlight them in yellow.
5. Use the following conjunctions at least once and highlight them in green:
